- a) The information contained in this application is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
- b) I have inspected the land applied for, and have found no evidence of occupation (with the exception of No. 6, and No. 7 on Page 1, where applicable)
- c) I am not aware of any adverse claim to the land applied for by any person(s).
- e) I fully understand that acceptance of this application by the Makkovik Inuit Community Government does not give me any rights or privileges in relation to the land under application.
- f) I fully understand that legal title shall not be transferred to me until Development has begun, as defined in permit application, and all fees indicated in Schedule A of Makkovik Community Land by-law is paid.
- g) I fully understand that the Makkovik Inuit Community Government may cancel the land application, should there be no development after two years (plus ten days after written notification that the application for land has expired) from the date of approval, and that if there is no response from the applicant within these ten days to indicated that he/she would like to re-apply, Makkovik Inuit Community Government may accept further applications on the proposed lot.
- h) Once ready to develop the land, I will submit an application and understand that legal title will be transferred once the applicant has some form of "development" started, as defined in the permit applications, and meets the zoning requirements.
- i) There will be a homeowner's discount of \$ 250.00, which will be available to applicants once development has commenced, as defined in the permit application submitted to Makkovik Inuit Community Government.
